3.14 Health Run

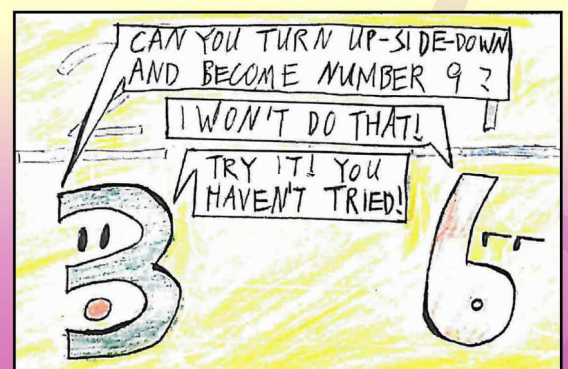
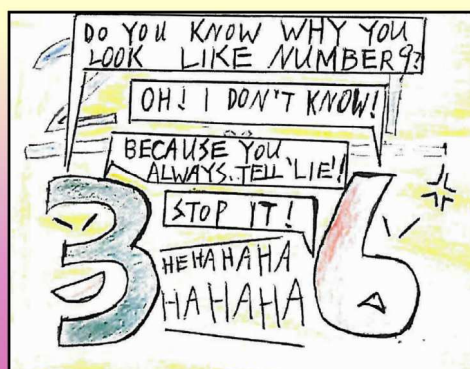
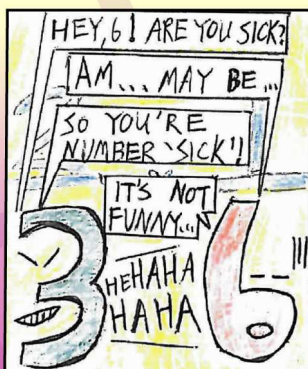
How would you feel if you were invited to run 5.25 km? Shocked? Excited? Or surprised?

Juice Express on Sports Day

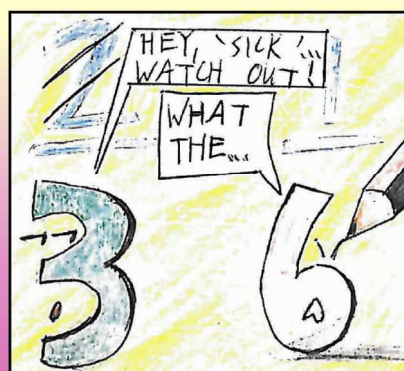
