Thank you for all your hard work. I truly appreciate it.



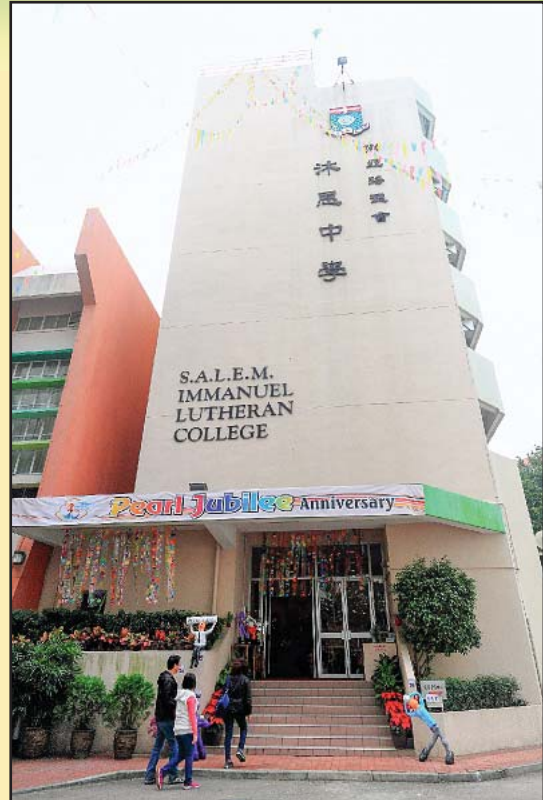

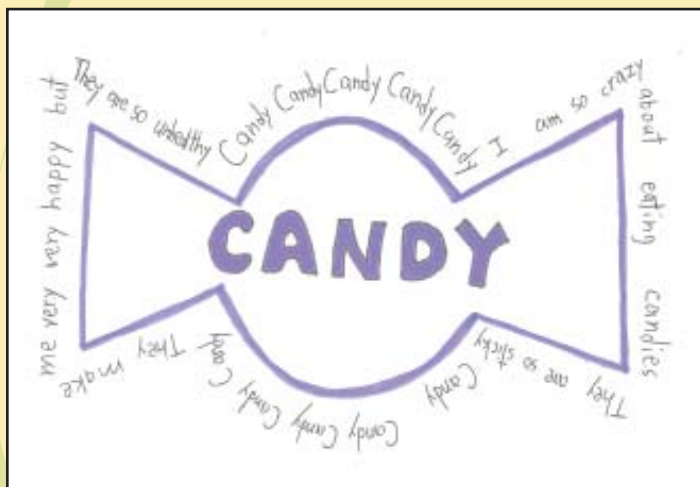

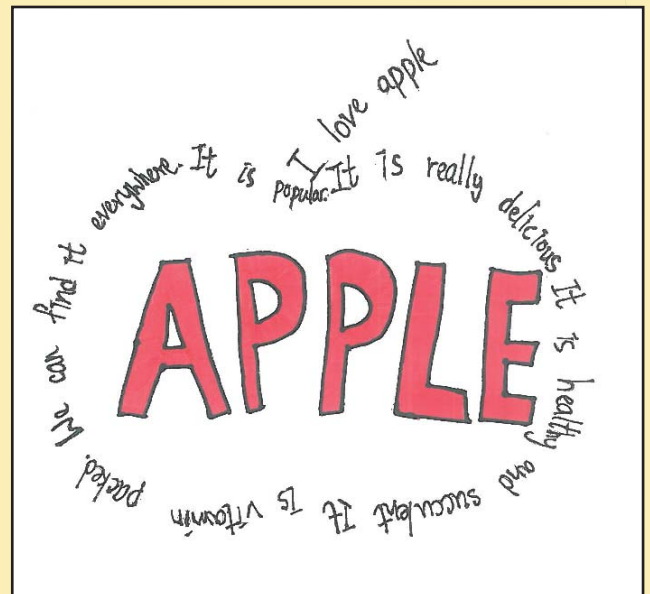
