

**SALEM-Immanuel Lutheran College**  
**After-school Learning and Support Grant (2023-24)**

Revised on 5th Apr 2024

**A. Purpose**

The EDB has implemented the After-school Learning and Support Grant Programmes (the Programme) since the 2005/06 school year to support the disadvantaged students to participate in after-school activities with a view to facilitating their whole-person development and personal growth.

**B. Scope of subsidies**

- (a) Subject-based learning activity (e.g. academically-oriented tutorial service, study skills training, and
- (b) personal development (e.g. Life-wide Learning activities, overseas learning activities, cultural and art activities, sports activities, leadership training, voluntary service, visits, etc.)

*Applicants only need to submit **ONE** application form. The school will flexibly approve the subsidy under the ‘Student Activities Support Grant’ or ‘School-based After-school Learning and Support Scheme’ based on the nature of activities the students participate in, provided that the total amount of subsidy available to students for the same activity will not exceed the fee required for the activity.*

**C. Target**

All S.1-S.6 students who have participated in extracurricular activities organized or recognized by school and meet one of the following criteria may apply for the subsidy.

- 1. Students receiving "Comprehensive Social Security Assistance" (CSSA).
- 2. Students receiving full grant under School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS-Full).
- 3. Students defined as “financially needy” by the school, e.g. receiving half grant under School Textbook Assistance Scheme (STAS-Half).

**D. Amount of subsidy**

- (a) It will be adjusted with reference to the financial condition of the family.
- (b) It will be adjusted with reference to the cost of each activity and the number of participants.
- (c) The exact amount of funding for each activity will be announced later.

**E. Date of application**

Scope of subsidies	Period of activities	Date of application
Subject-based learning activity	<u>Phase I:</u> 1.9.2023 to 31.5.2024	<b>5.4.2024-31.5.2024</b>
Life-wide learning and overseas learning activities and social services	<u>Phase II:</u> 1.6.2024 to 31.8.2024	<b>2.9.2024-6.9.2024</b>

Remarks: Application should be made on or before **9.1.2024** for S.6 students.

**F. Application**

- (a) Download the relevant form on school website or obtain it from school office.
- (b) Complete and return the form with signature of the teacher responsible and the attendance record (if any) to school office.
- (c) Appropriation Letter will be given by the school to the successful applicant after assessment.
- (d) Successful applicant shall return the slip of the Appropriation Letter to school office before the designated date.
- (e) Students collect the cheque given by the school and sign for acknowledgement.

**Late application will NOT be accepted.**
